LOCAL UPDATES

Taxes

Aruba taxes have been changed since the September 2017 election. Certain changes have taken effect as follows: as of July 1, 2018 the BBO and BAZV (local sales taxes) increased from 3.5% to 6.0%, and as of January 2019 a Sin Tax of \$6 per liter for liquor and wine was implemented.

Boardwalk at Malmok

The minister of tourism confirmed construction of a new boardwalk for the Malmok residential area. The boardwalk project started in March 2019 and will be carried out in two phases. The first phase should be completed by December 2019. First phase includes construction from Arashi to Malmok where hardwood and

pavers will be installed at the boardwalk. Light reflectors will also be installed to separate oncoming traffic and pedestrians. A small wall will be built alongside the boardwalk to prevent loggerhead sea turtles from reaching the road from the beach. This project will further enhance the vacation experience for those who enjoy this route for their early power walks and runs.

New Baggage System at Aruba Airport – Queen Beatrix International Airport

The Aruba Airport Authority has signed a \$33 million agreement with BEUMER Group for the design and installation of a new high-speed baggage transportation and sortation system. The new system will include a screening and weight identification system and will streamline the U.S. preclearance process at the Aruba Airport. It will also eliminate the requirement to reclaim checked luggage and undergo the second passenger screening process, which will significantly improve the traveling experience for U.S. residents.

Plastic Awareness

The government of Aruba has focused on ensuring the island becomes more environmentally conscious. Plastic bags have been banned from the island for the past two years. In addition, the government announced that as of January 2020 they will enforce the usage of recycled and biodegradable packaging for meals.

As a complex, plastic straws have been removed and biodegradable straws are available upon request. In April, Captain's Galley introduced durable cups which will help eliminate plastic cup usage.

Government Beach Policy Update

The government Beach Policy was introduced in January of 2018. Thus far, the government has been communicating with hotels and resorts regarding the stages of the Beach Policy to be in compliance. The first part was to relocate the areas of the three vendors that are in front of Aruba Surf Club which was completed in December of last year. Significant changes for Aruba Surf Club include relocating the first two lines of palapas to create a safety corridor. We are awaiting the due date to have these moves completed.
