According to the Bylaws for this Association, each one (1) week Owner is entitled to 24 votes for each Director being elected or issue being voted upon. This year you are electing three (3) members to the Board and are entitled to 72 votes (24 votes multiplied by 3 Directors) for every week you own. You may cast your votes in any whole number increment you desire (cumulative voting applies). See Candidate Profiles for a summary of the candidates.
