Greetings from your "Home away from Home" in Aruba! It is my pleasure to provide you a brief update on the upcoming Annual Meeting, projects completed in 2017, what has been accomplished so far in 2018, as well as future plans. A more detailed update will be sent in June.

By now you should have received the 2018 Notice of Annual Meeting and Limited Proxy. At the next Annual Meeting, scheduled for May 17, 2018, Owners will elect two A-members and one B-member to serve on the Board of Directors. In order to hold a valid meeting of the membership, the Association **must obtain quorum** which is 25% of the total voting interests. As of today, the Association has not met the quorum requirement. Not obtaining the required number of voting interests to hold the Annual Meeting will result in additional follow-up campaigns to those Owners who have not submitted their Limited Proxy with the goal of obtaining quorum. **Each additional mailing is an additional expense to the Association.** If you are not planning to attend the Annual Meeting, it is important that you, as an Aruba Surf Club Owner, vote and return your Limited Proxy.

### **Resort Updates**

- The energy conservation efforts have yielded positive results. In 2017, there were savings in the following utility consumption:
  - Electricity: 5.7% savings year over year (over 968K kilowatt hours)
  - Water: 10.6% savings year over year (over 6M Gallons)
- Beach and Serenity Pool restrooms were completed
- Replacement of signage replacement in all buildings is in progress
- Biminis were added on all pool deck chairs around the Lazy River and the Main Pool

### **Upcoming Projects for 2018**

- The 10-year renovation of the Compass Tower is scheduled to begin August 18, 2018, with an estimated completion of November 17, 2018; the building will remain open through the whole project as work will be conducted only by sets of floors at a time without disturbing the enjoyment of Owners and guests.
- Building façade cleaning, painting and re-sealing of Spyglass Building
- Replacement of air conditioner units in Spyglass Building
