In connection with updating your records, a **Certificate of Voting** form is included. **If you previously completed and returned a Certificate of Voting form, you do not need to complete the form again unless you wish to designate a new voting member.** If completing a form, you may complete it online by entering the name of your designated voting member, signing and submitting electronically. Single, individual Owners do not need to complete a form.

You may appoint the designated proxy holder named on your Limited Proxy, or you may write in the name of another person that you wish to act as your proxy holder. The person you designate must be in attendance at the Annual Meeting for your vote to be counted.
- d. Mail the Limited Proxy in the enclosed postage-paid envelope.
