Or, you may complete the form electronically by entering the name of your designated voting member, signing and submitting online. Single, individual Owners do not need to complete a form.

2. **The number of Directors shall be fixed each year by the Association at its Annual Meeting** (Item 3 on your Limited Proxy)

Bylaws, 2.1: "The management and operation of the Project and the administration of the affairs of the Association shall be conducted by a Board consisting of not less than five (5) nor more than seven (7) persons. The first Board shall consist of five (5) persons appointed by the Developer, and it shall serve until the first meeting of the members of the Association, at which time and election of all the members of the Board shall be conducted. The number of the directors shall be fixed each year by the Association at its annual meeting, provided that the number of directors may be decreased or increased subject to the foregoing limitations and, if increased, the additional directors may be elected by the members of the Association at any special meeting called for such purpose. Each director shall be an Owner and a member of the Association, or a designated officer of a member, or affiliate of such member, of an Owner if such Owner is a limited liability company, or designated officer or employee of such Owner if such Owner is a corporation, or a designated general partner of an Owner if such Owner is a general partnership or a limited partnership."

Increasing the number of the Board of Directors may increase Operating expenses to the Association.
